## INTRO TO DRAMA

**CREATING:** creating characters, devising ghost stories. Use of dramatic techniques

**PERFORMING:** performing a variety of scenes building to a final piece

UNDERSTANDING: atmosphere, impact on audience, use of sound & lighting for effect

ANALYSING: Self-evaluate, analyse

# **DEVISING MONOLOGUE**

**CREATING:** devising from stimulus, developing character, script writing

**ANALYSING:** self/peer evaluate performances, analyse a variety of devised productions



### **VERBATIM THEATRE**

**CREATING:** application of dramatic techniques, devising verbatim scenes, script writing

PERFORMING: set/costume/lighting/ sound design, interpretation of text

**UNDERSTANDING:** style, genre, theatre

history, staging

**ANALYSING:** self/peer evaluate performances, analyse The Stones



# **ROMEO & JULIET**

**CREATING:** set design, costume design, structure, staging

**PERFORMING:** interpretation of text, characters, applying acting & design skills

**UNDERSTANDING:** staging, use of set, impact on audience, style, genre, history

**ANALYSING:** analyse and evaluate full production of Romeo and Juliet
