Task: How does the writer use language to show Subhi's feelings towards Eli?

Subhi has a brother-like bond with Eli and they are very close because they share the same experiences. Both boys are refugees in a detention centre. The writer uses a unit of three to present the character of Eli, "...he's my best friend and we tell each other everything there is to tell. Eli says we're more than best friends. We're brothers." This shows that the character of Subhi looks up to Eli for support and for guidance. He respects him and he loves him because they have had the same experience in fleeing conflict. The writer wanted to show this deep bond at the beginning of the book to highlight the importance of relationships.

Use of **subject terminology** shows **clear understanding** of language choices.

Evidence from the text [quotations] are used to show clear understanding.

Some **connotations** show a clear understanding of the text but are more explicit.

Understands that the writer makes choices about language and structure and how this affects the reader.

Paragraphs show clear understanding of the text using relevant evidence to support ideas.

Analysis, shown through **connotations** is evident, but more explicit than implicit.
