	<p>Assessment/ Reporting – much clearer about successes and areas to develop. Low scores – if parents have questions about these – can teachers be in touch? If no homework has been set can N/A be used?</p> <p>Planner: no parental comment box – re-introduce? Or encourage notes to be written on the day section. General consensus is that planners are no longer needed. Photocopied timetables available/ laminated.</p> <p>Lunchtime: not long enough – to get food through. Allowed to go overdrawn on Arbor.</p> <p>Can parents request a cap on daily spend? Parents can request this for the tills. Parents/carers should email kitchen@ca.rklt.co.uk for a child specific cap.</p> <p>Can Arbor automatically email if students are overdrawn? No – parentpay used to do this. Our Business and Operations Manager will request if Arbor can do this.</p> <p>Queue management – Year 8 student often being pushed past? Years 8 and 9 have a separate queue so this shouldn't happen. Year 8s should have a separate queue at break as well. Mr Addison will remind duty staff to be vigilant. Mr Addison will offer a tour at the next Parental Forum. Year 8 queue is usually gone after about 12 minutes.</p> <p>Parents Evenings: reminders about sticking to 5 minutes. This to be communicated to parents and teachers.</p> <p>Rugby – white t shirts getting wrecked through mud!
