1	Supporters of Crawshaw Academy (SOCA)	5	Mr Addison (Headteacher)
2	Uniform No desire for a summer uniform. Students can wear PE kits or uniform – with an email sent with as much notice as possible with freak weather.	15	
3	Rewards Parents/ carers broke off into smaller groups and gave feedback: - Food based – free meals e.g. breakfasts - Queue Jump - High Street vouchers - Badges and certificates - Activity of choice e.g. cinema afternoon/ sports etc - Extra time at break/ lunch. - Extra responsibilities – around school – to act as role models. - Big rewards: cinema vouchers - Cinema afternoon in school can be a problem for some students – students’ behaviour - Twice yearly rewards – Alton Towers – but smaller afternoons e.g. Bowling – Flamingo land – is it cheaper? - Consideration of SEND students – sensory overload. - Bowling – Shipley Bowl cater for schools and for students with sensory concerns. - Can be smaller rewards/ opportunities. Low key awards. - Positive discipline every half term – extended form time. Two students nominated by each class – one nominated by students and one nominated by peers – and receive a reward. One person for each year group gets selected for the Headteachers award and get hot chocolates/ treats etc. - Awards evening – twice a year?	15	Mr Addison (Headteacher)

	- Star students/ star of the month – more regular awards for each subject area. Careful of the stigma of being picked out. - Can badges lead to queue jumping? - Mirror the attendance push with a rewards trolley? - Chef of the week – a popular one. - More consistency with ClassCharts – still too much variability – Need to push for more consistency. - With food awards – make sure there is enough food and we don't run out. - Option of phone call home/ queue jump/ raffle prize – choice appreciated. IAD against phone calls as these should be routine. - Bigger trips are appreciated but smaller and more often rewards are appreciated as well e.g. playing football with friends etc. Extra time as well. - Make sure we appreciate that for some SEND students the trips can cause anxiety.		
4	Future Plans for the Parental Forum - ½ termly meetings - Next meeting – discussion about uniform going forward e.g. boys and wearing shorts. - Student Leadership opportunities – IAD to look into.		
5	Feedback from Parents/ Carers - School Trips and if students get on them. Making sure that students who have been on one trip move down the list for future trips. IAD to speak to Mr Hand about the criteria and the issues of using positive points. - Put out a future calendar of the trips over the next 5 years for a students' experiences. For next year's year 7. - Make sure the criteria is publicised prior to the trip information going out. - Activity week in July? - Can we provide something for next year's Year 11 students? They are the year group who have missed out on anything. - Parent Forum to come along to Open Evening.
